The City of Branson West is currently seeking qualified men and women for the position(s) of Police Officer. ## Salary and Benefits:

- Entry wage for police officers is \$21.00 per hour (\$43,680.00 annually). Branson West Police Officers work 4/10-hour days (when staffing allows), holidays and weekends.
- Health insurance is available through the City of Branson West. The city pays the employee's premium and 72.5% of dependent coverage.
- Dental Insurance is available for all full-time employees and their dependents. The city pays the employee's premium and 72.5% of dependent premiums.
- A vision plan is available for all full-time employees and their dependents. The city pays the employee's premium and 72.5% of dependent premiums.
- The City of Branson West provides life insurance for full-time employees and their dependents: employee - \$20,000 with option for more at employees' expense.
- Vacation: 1 year – 1 week, 2-9 years – 2 weeks, 9-14 years – 3 weeks, 15+ years – 4 weeks.
- Paid Holidays: 14 holidays per year
- Personal Day: 2 days per year
- Sick Leave: 96 hours per year (earned at 8 hours per month).
- Retirement system (LAGERS): Employee contribution calculated at 4% of employee's wages. The City also contributes to the retirement fund at variable rates. Employee is vested after 5 years of service.
- City of Branson West provides all uniforms and equipment except footwear.
- Optional Benefits: Deferred compensation plans and accident, cancer, and critical care/cancer plans are available.

To qualify for a position with the Branson West Police Department, an applicant must meet the following criteria.

## Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be 21 years of age at the time of appointment.
- Must be a citizen of the United States and a resident of the State of Missouri at the time of appointment.
- Must be of good character, with no felony convictions, pending indictments, or certain misdemeanor offenses including any involving aggressive or violent behavior (i.e. domestic violence, criminal assault, etc.) disregard for the safety of others, or misuse of deadly weapons.
- Must possess a valid Missouri Driver's License at the time of appointment.
- Must be Missouri POST certified to apply with a Class A certification at the time of appointment. There is no local residency requirement.
